This year, my team and I (and many of the other Comfort Dogs as well) designed and mailed a Christmas card to dozens of our loyal fans and

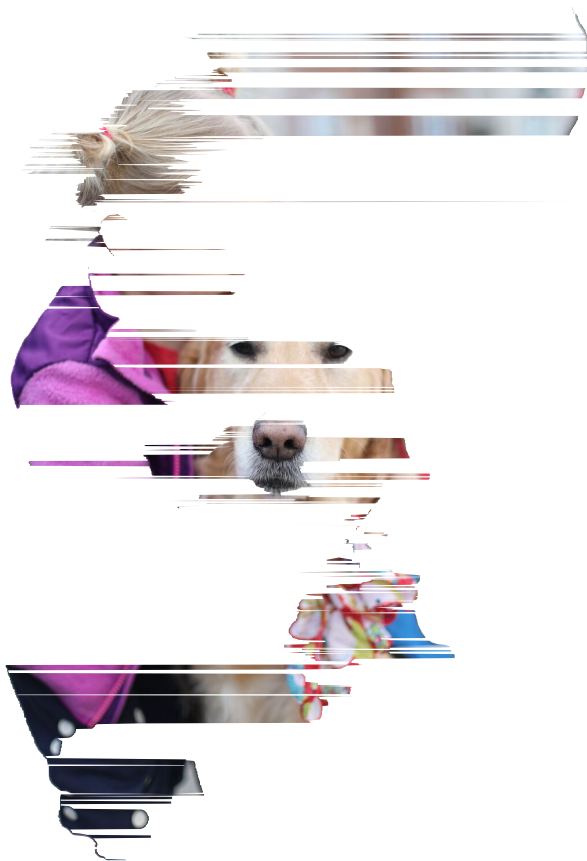
