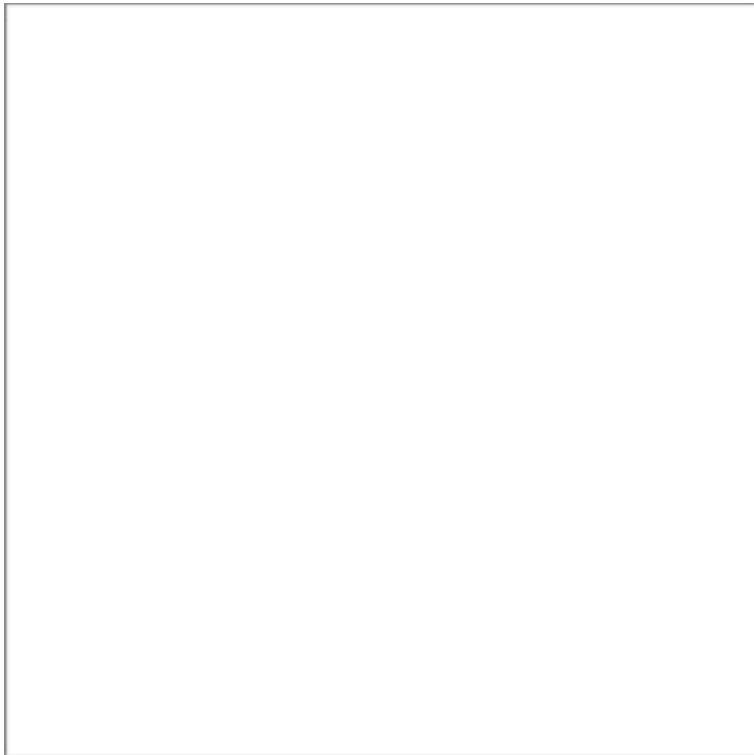


Lila's Log: Making Friends, Bringing Comfort, and Spreading our Lord's Message
